SYNOPSIS OF THE BILLS PASSED BY THE HARYANA VIDHAN
SABHA DURING THE AUGUST SESSION, 1974

1. The Haryana Home Guards Bill, 1974. (Introduced on the 16th August, 1974 and passed on the 16th August, 1974).

This bill while repealing the Home Guards Act, 1974, in its application to the State of Haryana, seeks to provide for the constitution of Haryana Home guards. It also seeks to make it obligatory for employers to permit members of Home guards to join duty when called upon and reckoning such period of duty as period spent in such employment.

2. The Haryana Police (Protection of Railways) Bill, 1974. (Introduced on the 16th August, 1974 and passed on the 16th August, 1974.)

This bill seeks to provide for enhanced punishments for certain derelictions of duty by members of the Police force.

3. The Haryana Abolition of Whipping Bill, 1974. (Introduced on the 16th August, 1974 and passed on the 16th August, 1974.)

The bill seeks to provide for the abolition of Whipping as a punishment in the State of Haryana.

4. The Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Haryana Amendment Bill, 1974. (Introduced on the 17th August, 1974 and passed on the 17th August, 1974.)

This bill seeks to authorize the State Government to get such collusive decrees, as are obtained by certain persons from Civil Courts in respect of Shamilat Lands, set aside and to bar Civil Courts' jurisdiction in such matters. It also provides for giving deterrent punishment to persons in wrongful or un-authorized possession of Shamilat lands.
