**SUMMONING, SITTING AND PROROGATION OF THE

**SYNOPSIS OF THE BILLS PASSED BY THE HARYANA
VIDHAN SABHA DURING THE AUGUST SESSION, 1975**

**(1) The Haryana State legislature Officers,
Ministers and Members (Medical Facilities) Bill, 1975.
(Introduced on the 9th August, 1975; passed on the 9th
August, 1975.)**

This Bill seeks to provide medical facilities to persons holding certain offices in Haryana State and the members of the Haryana Legislative Assembly, by repealing the Punjab State Legislature Officers, Ministers and Members (Medical Facilities) Act, 1965 (Punjab Act 26 of 1965) in its application to the State of Haryana.

**(2) The Haryana Legislative Assembly (Allowances
of Members) Amendment Bill, 1975. (Introduced on the 9th
August, 1975; passed on the 9th August 1975.**

This Bill seeks to amend the parent Act in order to entitle the Members (including the Chief Minister, a Minister, a Minister of State, a Deputy Minister, the Speaker, the Deputy Speaker, the Chief Parliamentary Secretary and a Parliamentary Secretary) to a constituency allowance of Rs. 200 p.m., so as to meet a part of the expenditure incurred by them in connection with the work concerning their respective constituencies.

**(3) The Rohtak University Bill, 1975. (Introduced
on the 9th August, 1975; passed on the 9th August, 1975).**

The Bill seeks to establish and incorporate a unitary teaching and residential University at Rohtak for the encouragement fo inter-disciplinary higher education and research with special emphasis on studies of Life Sciences and Environmemntal and Ecological Sciences.

(4) The Haryana Relief of Agricultural Indebtedness Bill, 1975. (Introduced on the 9th August, 1975; passed on the 9th August, 1975).

This Bill seeks to provide relief from indebtedness to landless labourers, rural artisans, marginal farmers and small farmers, by placing a moratorium for the recovery of loans due from them. This bill also bars the institution of all suits for the recovery of a debt as defined and stays all pending suits for a period of one year with powers to the Government to extend this period from time to time to two years in the aggregate.

(5) The Haryana legislative Assembly (Allowances of Members) Second Amendment Bill, 1975. (Introduced on the 9th August, 1975; passed on the 9th August, 1975).

This Bill seeks to amend the parent Act so as to enhance he rate of halting allowance to fifty-one rupees per day for each day of attendance at a meeting of the Assembly or Committee or in respect of journeys undertaken under the orders of the Speaker for any other business anywhere connected with his duties as a Member.

This Bill also seeks to provide one hundred rupees per mensem for the Members, Chief Minister, Ministers, Ministers of State Deputy Ministers, Speaker, Deputy Speaker,

Chief Parliamentary Secretary and the Parliamentary Secretary in lieu of telephone calls installed at their permanent places of residence.

OFFICIAL MOTION/RESOLUTION

1. Motion for the transaction of only Government Business during the session and suspension of certain rules of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Haryana Legislative Assembly.

On the 9th August, 1975, the Home Minister moved -

“That the House resolves that the current Session of the Haryana Vidhan Sabha (haryana Legislative Assembly) being in the nature of an emergent session to transact certain urgent and important Government business, only Government business be transacted during the session and no other business whatsoever including Questions, Calling Attention Notices and any other business to be initiated by a Private Member be brought before or transacted in the House during the Session and all relevant rules on the subject in the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Haryana Legislative Assembly do hereby stand suspended to that extent.”

The motion was put and carried without any discussion.

2. RESOLUTION UNDER ARTICLE 368 OF CONSTITUTION

On the 9th August, 1975, the Chief Minister moved :-

“That this House ratifies the amendments to the Constitution of India falling within the purview of the proviso

to cause (2) of article 368 thereof, proposed to be made by the Constitution (Fortieth Amendment) Bill, 1975, as passed by the two Houses of Parliament, and the short title of which has been changed into "The Constitution (thirty-ninth Amendment) Act 1975".

The Resolution was discussed on the 9th August, 1975 and remained before the House for sixty minutes. Eighteen Members including Ministers, from the Treasury Benches and two members from the Opposition Benches, participated in the debate, speaking for 51 minutes and 9 minutes respectively.

The Resolution was then put and carried.

Clauses 2 and 3 were put, one by one, and carried.

Sub-Clause(1) of Clause 1, the Enacting Formula and the Title were put, one by one, and carried.

The Chief Minister moved –

That the Bill be passed.

The motion was put and carried.

2. The Haryana Legislative Assembly (Allowances of Members) Amendment Bill, 1975.

The Bill was introduced by the Chief Minister at 10.55 a.m., who also moved –

That the Haryana Legislative Assembly (Allowances of Members) Amendment Bill be taken into consideration at once.

Ch. Partap Singh Daulata, a Member of the Opposition, spoke for one minute.

The motion was put and carried.

The Bill was then considered clause by clause.

Clauses 2 and 3 were put, one by one, and carried.

Clauses I, the Enacting Formula and the Title, were put, one by one, and carried.

The Chief Minister moved –

That the Bill be passed.

The motion was put and carried.

3. The Rohtak University Bill, 1975.

The Bill was introduced by the Education Minister at 10.58 a.m., who also moved –

The motion was put and carried.

4. The Haryana Relief of Agricultural Indebtedness Bill, 1975.

The Bill was introduced by the Revenue Minister at 11.15 a.m., who also moved –

That the Haryana Relief of Agricultural Indebtedness Bill be taken into consideration at once.

Sarvshri Amar Singh, Partap Singh Daulata and Abdur Razaq Khan, members from the Opposition Benches and Sarvshri Ram Dhari Gaur and Gulab Singh Jain, Members from the Treasury Benches, spoke for 11, 8, 1, 3 and 3 minutes respectively.

5. The Haryana Legislative Assemgly (Allowances of Members) Second Amendment Bill, 1975.

The Bill was introduced by the Chief Minister at 11.45. a.m., who also moved –

That the Haryana Legislative Assembly (Allowances of Members) Second Amendment Bill be taken into consideration at once.

No member rose to speak.

The motion was put and carried.

Clause 2

The Chief Minister moved –

In Clause 2, part (a), for the words “fifty-five rupees” the words “fifty-one rupees” be substituted.

The amendment was put and carried.

Clause 2, as amended, was put and carried.

Clause 3

After leave to move a New Clause having been granted, the Chief Minister moved the following new Clause 3 :-

“3. In Section 6 of the Haryana Legislative Assembly (Allowances of Members) Act, 1975 :-

(a) In sub-section (3), for the words “fifty-rupees”, wherever occurring the words “one hundred ruppees’ shall be substituted and

(b) the following Explanation shall be added at the end :-

‘Explanation:- Fro the purposes of sub-section (2) and (3), a Member shall include the Chief Minister, a Minister, a Minister of State, a Deputy Minister, the Speaker, the Deputy Speaker, the Chief Parliamentary Secretary and a Parliamentary Secretary.’”

The motion was put and carried.

Clause 1, the Enacting Formula and the Title were put, one by one, and carred.

The Chief Minister moved –

That the Bill, as amended, be passed.

The motion was put and carried.

IX. Leave of Absence.

The Speaker read out the following telegrams one by one sent by various Members requesting for leave of absence :-

(i) Grant leave of absence 20 to 30 July and 9th August/-Ch. Dal Singh.

(ii) Condone absence from attendance of Assembly Sessions held 28th to 30th July and commencing 9th August 1975 due to detention under MISA-Sarvshri Devi Lal and Ram Lal.

(iii) Failed attending Sessions 28th July, 1975 to 1st August, 1975 and 9th August, 1975 onward-lodged in jail-absence be condoned-Ch. Phool Chand (Rohat).

The leave asked for was granted by the Sabha.

The Sabha then adjourned Sine-die.

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
