Mr. Speaker: There is also a motion regarding the disapproval of the Punjab Panchayat Samitis (Haryana amemdment) Ordinance, 1977

If the house agrees the resoluion regarding the disapproval of the Punjab Panchayat Samitis (Haryana amemdment) Ordinance, 1977 and the motion that the Punjab Panchayat Samitis (Haryana amemdment) Bill be taken into consideration at once be discussed together and voted upon seperately.

(Voice: Yes)

Ch. Ram Lal Wadhwa (Karnal): Sir, I beg to move-

That this House disapproves the Punjab Panchayat Samitis (Haryana amemdment) Ordinance, 1977 (Haryana Ordinance no. 2 of 1977).

Mr. Speaker: Motion moved-

That this House disapproves the Punjab Panchayat Samitis (Haryana amemdment) Ordinance, 1977 (Haryana Ordinance no. 2 of 1977).

Agriculture Minister (Col. Maha Singh): Sir, I beg to move-That the Punjab Panchayat Samitis (Haryana amemdment) Bill be taken into consideration at once.

Mr. Speaker: Motion moved-

That the Punjab Panchayat Samitis (Haryana amemdment) Bill be taken into consideration at once.

चौधरी राम लाल वधवा: स्पीकर साहब, पहले जो आर्डिनैस पंजाब पंचायत समितिज (हरियाणा अमेंडमेंट) आर्डिनैस, 1977 जारी हुआ था, उसकी क्लोज 2 में यह था:-

2. After sub-section (1) of section 15 of teh Punjab Panchayat Samitis Act, 1961, the following sub-section shall be inserted, namely:-

“(1A) Notwithstanding any thing contained in the proviso to clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 15, no person shall incuror deemed to have incurred the disqualification specified in clause (0) of section 6, if he or his spouse gets

sterilized with in a period of three months from the date of commencement of the Punjab Panchayat Samitis (Haryana Amendment) Ordinance, 1977.”

और उसके विरुद्ध मैंने डिस्पूवल के मोटन का नोटिस दिया था, लेकिन स्पीकर साहब, अब जो बिल पेश हुआ है, उससे पता चलता है कि सरकार जल्दी भाग रही हैं। स्पीकर साहब, मैंने आर्डिनैस की क्लोज पढ़ी और उसके विरुद्ध मेरा डिस्पूवल का नोटिस था, लेकिन अब सरकार भाग क्यों रही है, यह मेरी समझ में नहीं आता। सरकार जो बिल अब लाई है, उसमें यह है “2. In section 6 of the Punjab Panchayat Samitis Act, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act,) clause (0) shall be omitted and shall always be deemed to have been omitted.”

3. For Clause (a) of Sub-section (10) of Section 15 of the Principal Act, the following clause shall be substituted and shall always be deemed to have been substituted, namely:-

(a) he becomes to any of the disqualifications specified in section 6: or

4. That the Punjab Panchayat Samitis (Haryana amendment) Ordinance, 1977 (Haryana Ordinance no. 2 of 1977), is hereby repealed”.

And in the statement of Objects and Reasons it is stated-

“In view of administrative difficulties it is proposed to omit the provisions in the Punjab Panchayat Samitis Act,

1961 regarding sterilization of Members of Punjab Panchayat Samitis. It also proposed to repeal the the Punjab Panchayat Samitis (Haryana amemdment) Ordinance, 1977 (Haryana Ordinance no. 2 of 1977) तो स्पीकर साहब, यह तो वही बात हो गई कि:-

की मेरे कत्ल के बाद उसने जफा से तौबा

हाय इस जूदे प ोमां का प ोमां होना

स्पीकर साहब, इस बिल के आने के बाद कहने के लिए तो कोई बात नहीं है, लेकिन क्या मैं सरकार से आपके जरिए यह पूछ सकता हूं कि यह जो पांच सूत्री कार्यक्रम चलाया था, उसके अन्दर यह भी एक कार्यक्रम था, जिसके द्वारा इनको बहुत बड़ी हार हासिल हुई है। क्या मैं पूछ सकता हूं कि सरकार उन पांच सूत्रों में से एक सूत्र को छोड़ रही है (विघ्न) स्पीकर साहब, उसके बाद इस बिल में 'एडमिनिस्ट्रेटिव डिफिकल्टी' लिखा है, तो क्या मैं यह समझूं कि इनको सिपाही नहीं मिलते या पुलिस वैगनज खत्म हो गई हैं या डाक्टर अवेलेबल नहीं हैं (विघ्न)।

परिवहन मंत्री (श्री के.एल. पोसवाल): आप चाहते क्या हैं ?

चौधरी राम लाल वधवा: मैं चाहूंगा कि सराकर इस बात को क्लैरिफाई करे कि इस प्रोग्राम को क्यों खत्म कर रही है। क्या वह मानती है कि उन्होंने जो कुछ किया है, वह गलत था,

ऐसा नहीं करना चाहिए और इसीलिए ये यह बिल ले आए हैं कि इसको वापिस किया जाए ? क्या हरियाणा के सारे पंच और सरपंचों का स्टर्लाईजे ज्ञान हो गया है और इसकी अब कोई जरूरत नहीं रही है ? इस प्रोग्राम को पूरा करने में क्या डिफिकल्टीज आ गई है, सरकार को क्या तकलीफ रही है ? मैं समझता हूँ कि इन्हें कोई तकलीफ नहीं रही है, अगर तकलीफ रही है तो वह जनता को रही है जिसके साथ जोर और जबरदस्ती की कार्यवाही हुई है, इनको तो कोई तकलीफ नहीं है, इनके पास डाक्टर कायम है, फ़ैमिली प्लानिंग के सैन्टर कायम है, इनको क्या डिफिकल्टी आ गई ? मैं आशा करता हूँ कि मंत्री महोदय इस प्वायंट को क्लैरिफाई करेंगे। इसके अतिरिक्त स्पीकर साहब, इस बिल के सम्बन्ध में और कहने की आवश्यकता तब थी अगर सरकार इस चीज को वापिस लेता हूँ। (हंसी) मैं कहना चाहता हूँ कि सरकार को अब अकल आ गई हैं, लेकिन बहुत देर के बाद आई है। अब यह आगे के लिए सुधार करने की कोशिश कर रही है और देखना है कि कितना सुधार कर पाते हैं।

आबकारी तथा कराधान मंत्री (श्री भयाम चन्द): स्पीकर साहब, हम इन्तजार कर रहे हैं, अब जनता पार्टी की हकूमत आएगी और वह कानून बनाएगी, हम इस बात को देख रहे हैं।

श्री गिरी । चन्द्र जो ि (यमुनानगर): स्पीकर सहाब, यह जो बिल हाउस के सामने आया है, मैं इसके बारे में कुछ विचार प्रकट करना चाहता हूं। सबसे पहले तो मैं अपने मुख्य मंत्री महोदय के प्रति आभार प्रकट करता हूं कि इन्होंने इस प्रोफ़े अनल टैक्स को पहली अप्रैल, 1977 से खत्म कर दिया है। हरियाणा में यह टैक्स बहुत पहले से चला आ रहा था। यह टैक्स सरदार प्रताप सिंह कैरो के टाईम पर लगा था। यह टैक्स मजदूरों, बैंक एप्लाइज, सैन्ट्रल गवर्नमेंट एम्पलाइज और एल.आई.सी. एम्पलायज वगैरह पर लगा हुआ था। जो भी सैन्ट्रल गवर्नमेंट का एम्प्लाइ हरियाणा में आता था, उस पर यह टैक्स लगता था। उन्हें माहवारी आमदनी के हिसाब से यह टैक्स देना पड़ता था। मैं जब से विधान सभा में एम.एल.ए. बनकर आया हूं तभी से मुतवातर यह को ि । । करता आ रहा था कि यह टैक्स समाप्त होना चाहिए। हमारे मुख्य मंत्री महोदय मजदूर निवाज हैं उन्होंने मजदूरों की बात को माना, इसलिए मैं उनके प्रति आभार प्रकट किए बिना नहीं रह सकता कि उन्होंने हरियाणा के मजदूरों के लिए ही नहीं, बल्कि बैंक एम्प्लाइज, सैन्ट्रल गवर्नमेंट एम्प्लाइज और एल.आई.सी. एम्प्लाइज का भी भला किया है। इन भाबदों के साथ मैं इस बिल का समर्थन करता हूं।

चौधरी रिजक राम (राई): स्पीकर साहब, यह जो बिल हाउस के सामने आया है, इसका सभी भाई स्वागत करेंगे। इस बिल पर एक बात थोड़ी सी चर्चा करने की है। इस टैक्स को
