FINANCIAL BUSINESS

1. THE SUPPLEMENTARY ESTIMAGES 2012-2013 (FIRST INSTALLMENT)

The Supplementary Estimates 2012-2013 (First Installment) were presented by the Finance Minister to the Sabha on the 27th August, 2012 and voted on the same day i.e. 27th August, 2012.

There were 29 demands in all totaling Rs. 2352,18,10,000/-.

**SYNOPSIS OF BILLS PASSED BY THE HARYANA VIDHAN
SABHA DURING AUGUST SESSION, 2012.**

1. The Haryana Legislative Assembly (Salary, Allowance and Pension of Members) Amendment Bill, 2012. (Introduced and passed on 27th August, 2012)

This Bill seeks to amend the principal Act keeping in view the status of Members of Legislative Assembly and Ex-Members, with a view to provide them the facility to travel in air-conditioned coaches by making an amendments in Section 7 and Section 7C of the Haryana Legislative Assembly (Salary, Allowance and Pension of Members) Act, 1975.

2. The Haryana Sh. Durga Mata Sh.ne Bill, 2012 (Introduced and passed on 27th August, 2012)

This Bill seeks to provide for the better management, administration ad governance of Sh. Durga Mata Sh.ne, Banbhor, Hissar and its endowments including the lands and buildings attached or appurtenant to the Sh.ne.

3. The Haryana Private Technical Educational Institute (Regulation of Admission and Fee) Bill, 2012 (Introduced and passed on 27th August, 2012)

The Bill seeks to provide of admission and fee for technical course run by a private technical educational institution in the State of Haryana and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

4. The Haryana State Commission for Women Bill, 2012 (Introduced and passed on 27th August, 2012)

The Bill seeks to constitute Haryana State Commission for Women and to provide for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

5. The Haryana Appropriation (No. 3) Bill, 2012 (Introduced and passed on 28th August, 2012)

The Bill seeks to authorize payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the consolidated Fund of the State of Haryana for the services during the financial year ending on the thirty first day of March, 2013.

6. The Haryana Prohibition of Ragging in Educational Institution Bill, 2012 (Introduced and passed on 27th August, 2012)

The Bill seeks to repeal the Haryana Prohibition of Ragging in Educational Institution Ordinance, 2012 (Haryana Ordinance No. 3 of 2012) and to provide for prohibition of ragging in educational institutions in the State of Haryana and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

7. The Maharshi Dayanad University (Second Amendment) Bill, 2012 (Introduced and passed on 28th August, 2012)

The Bill seeks to amend the principal Act with a view to take suitable steps for amending Act so as to bring the same in conformity with the observations made by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and adhere the same in all future

cases and to stop all the State/State Private Universities in the State from operation beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the State in any manner either in the form of the offcampus/study centre/affiliate college and the centres operation through franchises.

8. Bhagat Phool Singh Mahila Vishwavidyalaya Khanpur Kalan (Second Amendment) Bill, 2012 (Introduced and passed on 28th August, 2012)

This Bill seeks to amend the principal Act with a view to take suitable steps for amending the existing Act so as to bring the same in conformity with the observations made by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and adhere the same in all future cases and to stop all the State/State Private Universities in the State from operation beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the State in any manner either in the form of the off-campus/study centre/affiliate college and the centres operation through franchises.

9. The Kurukshetra University (Second Amendment) Bill, 2012 (Introduced and passed on 28th August, 2012)

This Bill seeks to amend the principal Act with a view to take suitable steps for amending the existing Act so as to bring the same in conformity with the observations made by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and adhere the same in all future cases and to stop all the State/State Private Universities in the State from operation beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the State in any manner either in the form of

the off-campus/study centre/affiliate college and the centres operation through franchises.

10. Chaudhary Devi Lal University Sirsa (Second Amendment) Bill, 2012 (Introduced and passed on 28th August, 2012)

This Bill seeks to amend the principal Act with a view to take suitable steps for amending the existing Act so as to bring the same in conformity with the observations made by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and adhere the same in all future cases and to stop all the State/State Private Universities in the State from operation beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the State in any manner either in the form of the off-campus/study centre/affiliate college and the centres operation through franchises.

11. The Punjab Scheduled Road and Controlled Areas Restriction of Unregulated Development (Haryana Amendment) Bill, 2012 (Introduced and passed on 28th August, 2012)

This Bill seeks to repeal the Punjab Scheduled Roads and Controlled Areas Restriction of Unregulated Development (Haryana Amendment) Ordinance, 2012 (Haryana Ordinance No. 4 of 2012) with a view to omit clause (a) of section 22 for the purpose of applying the Act on the area adjacent to the abadi deh of any village which the Government identifies for village expansion through notification, published in the Official Gazette, specifically to this effect subject to the condition that this area shall not exceed sixty percent of the existing village abadi deh also.

This Bill further proposes to amend section 25(1) of the Act to make rules for carrying out the purpose of this Act and to give them prospective or retrospective effect.

12. The Punjab New Capital (Periphery) Control (Haryana Amendment) Bill, 2012 (Introduced and passed on 28th August, 2012)

This Bill seeks to repeal the Punjab New Capital (Haryana Amendment) Ordinance, 2012 (Haryana Ordinance No. 5 of 2012) with a view to omit clause (a) of section 15 for the purpose of applying the Act on any building erected to re-erected for bonafide personal residential purpose and not above the height of eleven meters or for purposes subservient to agriculture in the abadi area of any village as defined in the revenue record and the area adjacent to the abadi area of any village which the Government identifies for village expansion through a notification, published in the Official Gazette, specifically to this effect subject to the condition that this area shall not exceed sixty percent of the existing village abadi area also.

13. The Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Amendment Bill, 2012 (Introduced and passed on 28th August, 2012)

This Bill seeks to amend the principal Act with a view to prevent commission of crimes during the period of parole/furlough and to reduce/eliminate the possibility of absconding during parole/furlough, so as to include further stringent provisions in the existing Act.

14. The Haryana Municipal (Amendment) Bill, 2012 (Introduced and passed on 28th August, 2012)

This Bill seeks to amend the principal Act with a view to formulate a new system of property tax calculation and to provide a huge relief to the common man, small traders and other segments of society. Certain amendment in the Act has been made so that the Act and property tax system are in tune with each other.

15. The Haryana Municipal Corporation (Amendment) Bill, 2012 (Introduced and passed on 28th August, 2012)

This Bill seeks to amend the principal Act with a view to formulate a new system of property tax calculation and to provide a huge relief to the common man, small traders and other segments of society. Certain amendment in the Act has been made so that the Act and property tax system are in tune with each other.

The amendment has also been made in order to address the problem of stray swines within the municipal limits and to make stringent legal provisions to contain this menace.

16. The Punjab Agricultural (Haryana Amendment) Produce Markets Bill, 2012 (Introduced and passed on 28th August, 2012)

This Bill seeks to amend the Principal Act with a view to harmonizing the Agricultural Produce Markets in the State and in order to introduce several reforms that are

expected to enhance accessibility off farmers to national and international markets for improved remunerative prices.

The proposed amendments also seek to facilitate establishment of electronics spot exchanges in order to improve farmers access to national and international markets and enhance remunerative prices.

The Bill further seeks to change the nomenclature of the Act from the Punjab Agricultural Produce Markets Act, 1961 to the Haryana Agricultural Produce Markets Acts, 1961.

The Speaker gave his ruling on the issue of casteist remarks made against Sh. Jaiveer Balmiki by Sh. Abhey Singh Chautala, M.L.A. as under:-

“Hon’ble Members, to verify the contents of the application submitted by Sh. Jaiveer Singh Balmiki, Chief Parliamentary Secretary wherein he has stated that he was called bad names even by ‘Jatisuchak shabd’ by Sh. Abhay Singh Chautala, M.L.A. in the House on 24.8.2012. I have enquired into the matter. I have watched the video clippings also which evidently depict that Sh. Abhey Singh Chautala, M.L.A. is visibly seen instigating other Members of INLD to show utter distegard to Sh. Jaiveer Singh Balmiki,. The gestures and action of Sh. Abhey Singh Chautala, M.L.A. certainly establishes the allegations levelled against him. Such kind of conduct should be deprecated. However, to close matter, to maintain harmony and for smooth functioning of the House, I am of the considered view that Sh. Abhey Singh Chautala, MLA should be reprimanded by the House so that such incidents will not repeated in futures. Since he has been suspended for the remainder of the Session, we will call him in the next sitting of the Session and we will call him to the bar of the House and reprimand him.”

He also quoted the Rule 120 of Rules of procedure and Conduct of Business in Haryana Legislative Assembly and the contents of book 'kale & Shidehara' which prohibits the legislators from wearing party symbols or emblems inside the House.

Sh. Om Parka Sh. Chautala and Sh. Sher Singh Barshami, Members from the Indian National Lok Dal insisted that this must be incorporated in the assembly Rules as at present there is no such provision in the Rules.

After hearing both the sides, the Speaker quoted the Rule 120 of Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in

Haryana Legislative Assembly and informed the House that Speaker can make a Rule and on account of this he gave his ruling that no Member can come inside the House wearing scarves with party name and symbol or black badges but the Members did not pay any heed to the request of hon'ble speaker. The Speaker repeatedly asked the members of Indian National Lok Dal to remove their scarves black badges.

All the Members from Indian National Lok Dal and a Member from the Shirmani Akali Dal present in the House staged a walk out a protest against the ruling given by Hon'ble Speaker to remove their party name and symbol scarves as also black badges.

The speaker requested the Members of to resume their seats as question hour was going on. the Members did not resume their seats and continued speaking without the permission of the Speaker. Kuldeep Sharma, M.L.A. (now Hon'ble Speaker) against Sh. Om Prakash Chautala, M.L.A. who made false statement on the floor of the House on 11th March, 2010 regarding imposing VAT on Salt which was made willfully, Deliberately and Knowingly by Sh. Om Prakash Chautala, M.L.A. thereby misleading the House and amounting to committing the contempt of the House/breach of privilege by him.

He also moved-

That the time for the presentation of the final Report to the House be extended upto the first sitting of the next Session.

The motion was put and carried

(ii) PRESENTATION OF PRELIMINARY REPORT OF COMMITTEE OF PRIVILEGES REGARDING PRIVILEGE

ISSUE AND EXTENSION OF TIME FOR PRESENTATION OF THE FINAL REPORT.

The Chairperson of the Committee (Dr. Raghuvir Singh Kadian) presented the Fifth Preliminary Report of the Committee of Privileges with regard to the question of alleged breach of privilege given notice of by Sh. Bharat Bhushan Batra, M.L.A. against Sh. Om Prakash Chautala, M.L.A. who made false, misleading and incorrect statement on the floor of the House on 11th March, 2010 willfully, deliberately and knowingly stating that the Haryana Urban Development Authority had not acquired a single acre of land since coming into power of the Congress Government from a single acre of land since coming into power of the Congress Government from March, 2005 till date. He has also stated that not even a single sector of HUDA had been floated during this period this period, whereas the Parliamentary Affairs Minister, Shri Randeep Singh Surjewala had pointed out the correct factual position but Sh. Om Prakash Chautala again asserted that neither even a single sector of HUDA was floated nor a single acre of land was acquired by HUDA from March, 2005 till date. By doing so Sh. Om Prakash Chautala has tried to mislead the House willfully, knowingly and deliberately which amounts to contempt of the House/Breach of Privilege committed by him on the floor of the House. Thus' the matter of making false statement by Sh. Om Prakash Chautala on the floor of the House on 11th March 2010, involves the question of Breach of Privilege/contempt of the House.

He also moved-

That the time for the presentation of the final Report to the House be extended upto the first sitting of the next Session.

The motion was put and carried.

(iii) PRESENTATION OF PRELIMINARY REPORT OF COMMITTEE OF PRIVILEGES REGARDING PRIVILEGE ISSUE AND EXTENSION OF TIME FOR PRESENTATION OF THE FINAL REPORT.

The Chairperson of the Committee (Dr. Raghuvir Singh Kadian) presented the Fifth Preliminary Report of the Committee of Privileges with regard to the question of alleged breach of privilege given notice of by Sh. Aftab Ahmed, M.L.A. against Shri Om Prakash Chautala, M.L.A. who made categorically incorrect and misleading statement on the floor of the House on 11th March, 2010 stating that Reliance Company has been given 1500 acres of Government land at a cost of Rs. 370 crore in garb of giving employment, particularly when HSIIDC had acquired this land for welfare of the people. He further stated that a four acres chunk of land out of this acquired land has been auctioned for Rs. 290 crore. He consequently alleged loss to the exchequer and fraud on account thereof. He further stated that land of farmers was acquired in the name of 'SEZ' and they were told that they will be given bonus/annuity of Rs. 10,000/- per acre per year. He further stated that even a rupee has not been paid till date to any farmer by way of such bonus/annuity. Whereas the above statement of Shri Om Prakash Chautala is factually and absolutely incorrect. Shri Om Prakash Chautala has made a false, misleading and incorrect statement in the

House on both the afore- stated subjects. Shri Om PrakaSh.Chautala made this statement willfully, deliberately and Knowingly to mislead this august House. This constitutes a matter of clear breach of privilege of the House. Thus, the matter of making false statement by Sh.Om PrakaSh.Chautla on the floor of the House on 11th march, 2010, involves the question of breach of privilege/contempt of the House.

He also moved-

That the time for the presentation of the final Report to the House be extended upto the first the first sitting of the next Session.

The motion was put and carried.

(iv) PRESENTATION OF PRELIMINARY REPORT OF COMMITTEE OF PRIVILEGES REGARDING PRIVILEGE ISSUE AND EXTENSION OF TIME FOR PRESENTATION OF THE FINAL REPORT.

The Chairperson of the Committee (Dr. Raghuvir Singh Kadian) presented the fourth Preliminary Report of the Committee of Privileges with regard to the question of alleged breach of privilege given notice of by Sh.Kuldeep Sharma, M.L.A. (now Hon'ble Speaker) against Shri Om PrakaSh.Chautala, M.L.A. Who made false, misleading and incorrect statement on the floor of the House on 6th September, 2010, stating that a news was being televised by some, News Channels that in the car and this car was owned by Sh.Gopal kanda . He also stated the number of Car as HR-70-L-0009. He further stated the girl was kidnapped from Delhi and was raped in Gurgaon. Therefore, the Government

should resign. Whereas, the above statement of Sh.Om PrakaSh.Chautala is factually and absolutely in the House. He also moved-

The motion was put and carried.

IV. ADJOURNMENT OF SITTING

(i) When the Speaker informed the House that he had admitted the Calling Attention Motion No. 3 given by Shri Bharat Bhushan Batra, M.L.A. regarding Medical Services/facilities to the citizens including pregnant women and infants, Sh.Om Prakash Chautala, a Member from the Indian National Lok Dal sought to know the fate of his party Members' Adjournment Motion regarding deteriorating law and order situation in the State. The Speaker told him that it had been disallowed. Thereafter, Sh.Ram Pal Majra and some Members of the Indian National Lok Dal and Sh.Anil vij, a Member from the Bhartiya Janata Party came into the well of the house and started waving papers. In the meantime, Sh.Jaiveer Balmiki, Chief Parliamentary Secretary sought justice for himself as well as for the sake of Balmiki Community. Some Members of the Treasury Benches also urged the Speaker to decide on the issue of casteist Chautala.

Sh. Ram Pal Majra and other Members of the Indian National Lok Dal objected it and disrupted the proceedings of the House without the permission of the chair. In spite of time and again having being disorder in the House.

On finding grave disorder in the House, the Speaker adjourned the sitting of the House at 3.20 P.M. for 15 minutes.

The house then adjourned at 3.20 P.M. and re-assembled at 3.35 P.M.

(ii) Immediately after re-assembling the House, some Members of the Indian National Lok Dal, Shiromani Akali Dal and Shri Anil Vij, a Member from the Bhartiya Janata Party again came into the well of the House and continued to disrupt the proceedings of the House. In the meantime, Shri Jaiveer Balmiki, chief Parliamentary Secretary again urged the Speaker to deliver justice. The Speaker requested the Members to resume their seats but the Member did not resume their seats and continued speaking without the permission of the Speaker whereupon the Speaker warned them repeatedly. Education Minister Smt. Geeta Bhukkal also urged the Speaker to give justice on the issue of casteist remarks made against Shri Jaiveer Balmiki. Some Members of the Treasury made Benches also came into the well of the House and protested the behaviour of the Members of the Indian National Lok Dal. There were heated exchanges from both the sides and there was an uproar in the House.

On finding uproar in the House, the Speaker called upon the Parliamentary Affairs Minister, the Leader of the

Indian National Lok Dal, Leader of the Bhartiya Janata party and Leader of the Haryana Janhit Congress (B.L.) to discuss this matter in his Chamber and again adjourned the sitting of the House at 3.55 P.M. for 15 minutes.

The house then adjourned at 3.55 P.M. and re-assembled at 4.10 P.M.

(iii) When House re-assembled at 4.10 p.m., the Hon' ble Deputy speaker occupied the Chair for a while and again adjourned the sitting of the House for another 10 minutes.

V. APPEALED BY THE CHAIR

When the House re-assembled at 4.20 P.M. the Speaker appealed to all the Members not to disrupt the proceedings of the futher and to maintain the dignity and decorum of the House. He urged all the Members not to disrupt the proceedings of the House further and to maintain the dignity and decorum of the House. He urged all the Members to co-operate him to run the House smoothly.

VI. ASPERSIONS AGAINST THE CHAIR

Even after the appealed made by the Speaker to maintain the dignity and decorum of the House, Sh.Om PrakaSh.Chautala, M.L.A. passed on certain objectionable unparliamentary remarks against the Chair. On this, the Parliamentary Affairs Misister and the Chief Minister took strong objection against the remarks cast by Sh.Om PrakaSh.Chautala, M.L.A. and requested the Speaker to order him to withdraw his remarks. The Speaker asked shri Om

PrakaSh.Chautala to withdraw his remarks, but he refused. The Chief Minister said that proceedings of the House would go on only if Sh.Om PrakaSh.Chauatala withdraws his words and apologizes for it. The Parliamentary Affairs Minister and the Chief Minister later urged the Speaker that if he does not withdraw his words then these may be expunged from the proceedings of the House.

Meanwhile, the Members of Indian Nation Lok Dal and Shiromani Akali Dal present in the House, again came into the well of the House and started raising slogans and created turmoil in the House. Simultaneously, some Members of the Treasury Benches also came into the well of the House and protested the attitude of the Opposition. There were heated exchanges from both the sides.

The Speaker later ordered that all such remarks be expunged from the proceedings of the House.

VII. RESOLUTION REGARDING CONDEMNING THE CONDUCT OF SHRI OM PRAKASH.CHAUTA, M.L.A.

The parliamentary Affairs Minister with the permission of the Speaker moved-

“That remarks passed by Shri Om PrakaSh.Chautala, Leader of the Opposition and aspersions and aspersions cast by him on the Chair and this august House not only be expunged but also his conduct should be condemned for casting such aspersions.”

The resolution was put and carried.

VIII. SUSPENSION OF MEMBERS

When the Speaker asked Shri Om PraKaSh.Chautala again to withdraw his remarks, all the members of the Indian National Lok Dal and shiromani Akali Dal, present in the House came to the well of the House and started raising slogans & disrupting the proceedings of the House. The Speaker requested them to resume their seats but all the members of Indian National Lok Dal and shiromani Akali Dal present in the House continued to obstruct the proceedings of the House. However, the speaker warned them repeatedly and requested them to take their seats but they did not pay any heed to the requests of the Speaker. There was a grave disorder in the House.

The Parliamentary Affairs Minister moved-

That Shri Abhey Singh Chautala, Shri Ajay Singh Chautala, Sh.Ashok Kashyap, Sh.Ashok kumar Arora, Sh.Bishan Lal, Sh.Bahadur singh, ShDharam Pal, Shri Dilbag Singh, Shri Ganga Ram, Sh.Hari Chand Middha, Sh.JagdiSh.Nayyar, Sh.kali Ram patwari, Sh.krishan Lal Panwar, Sh.Krishan Lal, ShMamu Ram, Sh.Mohammed Ilyas, ShriNarender Sangwan, Sh.Naseem Ahmed, Sh.Om PrakaSh.Chautala, Sh.Pardeep Chaudhary, Sh.Parminder Singh Dhull, Shri Prithi Singh, Sh.Rampal Majra, Smt. saroj, Shri Sher Singh Barara, Sh.Rameshwar Dayal, Sh.Chaudhary of Indian National Lok Dal and Sh.Charanjit Singh of Shiromani Akali Dal be suspended from the service of this House for their misconduct, most irresponsible behaviour unbecoming of the Member of this August House and their grossly disorderly conduct in the House for the remainder of the present Session.

The motion was put& carried.

**IX. RULING BY THE SPEAKER REGARDING THE
ISSUE OF CAST IST REMARKS MADE AGAINST SHRI
JAIVEER BALMIKIBY SHRI ABHEY SING CHAUTALA, M.A.L.**

The Speaker gave his ruling on the issue of castist remarks made against Shri Jaiveer singh Balmiki by Shri abhey singh Chautala, M.L.A.-

“Hon’ble Members, to verify the contents of the application submitted by Shri Jaiveer Singh Balmiki, Chief parliamentary Secretary wherein he has stated that he was called bad names even by ‘Jatisuchak shabd’ by Sh. Abhay Singh Chautala, M.L.A. in the House on 24.8.2012. I have enquired into the matter. I have watched the video clippings also which evidently depict that Shri Abhay Singh Chautala, M.L.A. is visibly seen instigating other Members of INLD to show utter disregard to Shri Jaiveer Singh Balmiki. the gestures and actions of shri Abhay Singh Chautala, M.L.A. certainly establishes the allegations the allegations levelled against him. such kind of conduct should be deprecated.
